- Some states are closing ramps
- NH and MA are still open so our anglers should take advantage of that responsibly

# Youth Report

- Youth Zoom Meeting on Saturday 4/18
  - Meeting had a very good turnout
  - o Professional angler John Crews was a special guest participant
- 1<sup>st</sup> Youth tournament on 5/8 has been cancelled
  - It's important for the captains who signed up for the first event to sign up for a new event
- Youth group is hosting a remote fishing challenge
  - o Promotes social distancing while still allowing members to fish and compete a little
  - Youth club members post photos of their catches and how they were caught in Team App
  - o Challenge will run May 1 through 15
- Junior national championship has been postponed to the fall
  - o Ray will get more information hopefully next week.
- New York Youth is hosting an open tournament in May

## President's Report New Business

- May 3<sup>rd</sup> open is cancelled
  - This event served as the NH College championship; the next open may need to serve as the championship
- July 19 at Winni West Alton is now the first scheduled open

#### Cancellations

- The reason for not rescheduling this year's cancelled NHBN tournaments is to avoid confusion and conflict as other national and local events are rescheduled
- NH BASS Nation does not currently recommend holding any type of organized event except for something like the Juniors photo challenge
  - Insurance will not cover these events because of the stay at home order
- We have until July 15 to file taxes
- Tournaments
  - Team of the Year will be based on remaining tournaments
  - o Top teams will go to championship
  - o No drops
- Regionals
  - These are being rescheduled
  - John is working with the state team on jerseys and registering
- Banquet
  - A lot of people have already purchased tickets
  - o Plan is to still conduct it, but likely in November
  - We do not want to combine 2019 with 2020
  - No date yet; there was a fire at the Puritan and it's unclear when the COVID situation will be better
- Tournament Scales
  - Have been fixed and returned
- State Team Discount
  - o Garmin is working with BASS to get a discount for the state team
- Sponsors
  - HUK is back on board as a sponsor
    - Discount Code: BASSNation
    - BASS will be checking membership; states that abuse sponsorship will lose it
      - Do not publish code on social media or public spaces
    - 40% Discount use as many times as you want
    - National Rosters
      - There are still some clubs who have not updated their rosters; do not send to members until rosters are complete
- Dues
  - o John does not intend to submit checks for state and club level rosters and dues until we see how things shake out.
  - o Banquet fees will be reimbursed if person is unable to make the new date
- STQT Cobbossee in September
  - This tournament is still on the schedule

### Other Business

- No update on Great East for Club v Club
- Should we consider having a cookout in the summer for everyone instead of the banquet
  - o People like the formality of the banquet and awards ceremony
  - With social distancing and Puritan having their issues, this could be another option
  - o First tournament funds state team, but banquet does not really
    - State team will take a ~600 dollar hit from missing first tournament

- May need to consider reallocating funds raised from a different tournament such as Folds of Honor to cover state team expenses
- o COVID Situation
  - It's not looking like we are going to be open so it doesn't make sense to plan anything new until we get more guidance from the state
- May meeting TBD
