  - a. Not a lot of activity

  - c. HS National accounts zeroed out
    - i. Checks for clothing
  - d. JR nationals account
    - i. Deposit of \$500
    - ii. There will be another deposit from Seven Lakes Marine
  - e. Operating account
    - i. Check for Lews rebates
      - Reels we give as prizes qualify for discounted jackets
    - ii. Check for advertising on Facebook
    - iii. Deposits for membership dues
  - f. State Team account
    - i. No activity
  - g. Total funds available 18869
  - h. Left over state team accounts are just leftover funds that we have not decided what to do with them yet
    - i. They are beginning to add up
    - ii. Ideally this money would go to equipment fund
      - Our tournament trailer is single axle
    - iii. Nothing will be leftover for 2021 state team account as funds will go to National competitors
    - iv. Leftover ~2k from 2020 state team is because there was no Regional Tournament
    - v. There will be under 4k at the end of the year
    - vi. Constitution has language about funding the Classic; we should consider updating this constitution language
      - This can be discussed in winter
      - There are two other rule change proposals from NH Basscasters

- 4. Youth Report
  - a. Wrapping up season last singles tournament this Saturday for JR Bassmasters on Mascoma
  - b. Season Finale HS Championship on 8/28; winner of that event and points winner of three previous HS events will qualify for BASS HS National Championship
  - c. Kudos to Cole Moulton had a great day on Champlain and is within two positions for AOY on that trail
  - d. Kudos to James Gillis and Craig Beucler (former NH JR Bassmasters) competed in College Championship representing NH and Clarkson University. Finished in 4<sup>th</sup> place
  - e. Thank you, volunteers!
  - f. From the tournament on Wentworth, there were a few extra boat captains who attended but did not get gas cards; Cole will be reaching out to captains who need gas cards. If you have captains in your club who did not receive gas cards, let us know.
