 - i. Jamie: We should start moving this way sooner than later because all of the other organizations are heading in that direction
 - ii. Dave: We should consider starting it as a requirement for next year as a lot of us are doing it already and if anglers make it to regionals or nationals they need to adhere to this anyway
 - iii. This would need to be a tournament rule change
 - iv. Note: Nets were not allowed at regionals; we may want to consider this for next year
- f. Recommendation for 2022 season rules
 - i. No penetrating cull tags
 - ii. No nets for STQT, but nets allowed for Team Opens
 - We will go with the TH marine cull tags
- g. Applied for 3 grants available. SLA Weed Watcher Program
 - i. Winners will likely be released at iCast

 - Not a good use of volunteer time
- Question: When did we learn that Silver Lake was charging the ~\$100 fee for parking?
 - We learned in June
 - Issue was around a town ordinance that passed that required non-residents to pay a \$100 fee to launch at their site, and their site is the only launch on the lake
 - Jamie will reach out to Fish and Game; fees from licensing and permitting are used to stock these lakes; it's unfair that these fees collected from anglers are stocking lakes anglers can't access
 - There are other towns doing this
