 - This worked really well and had great turnout. There were no issues on either end.

- d. 1125 from Regional Payout in 2022 State Team account. Where do we allocate?
 - i. Ideas

- Ginger Cookies at STQT
- Investing funds in the Junior and HS program to get the state equipment (weigh-in, trailer, etc.) up to the same level as the adult program
- Fizzing kits
- Money should stay within STQT/State team for small things
 - a. E.g. like gas cards/incentives for shuttles
 - b. If we start a new program with these funds, we should consider what happens once that money is gone
- Trailer
 - a. How do we go about planning for a new trailer
 - b. Current trailer is a single axle
 - c. We do have an equipment fund that is funded from sales of oil (8-10 dollars a gallon); other merchandise sales have also been deposited into this account (Huk, Aftco) but we are no longer making those sales
- Don't Spend
 - a. New Board of Directors starting up in a couple months
 - b. No rush to get rid of that money
 - c. Maybe just leave it there
- ii. NOTE: Money that state team won anglers received 75% of that money; 25% goes to BASS
- iii. Previous Ideas (from last meeting)
 - Trailer
 - Fizzing tank
 - Since this is State Team related, maybe we should stay within the realms of STQT: fizzing station, incentives for anglers at STQT like prizes for combined club weights, heaviest weight, heaviest boat weight, combined weight of boater and non-boater as a club
 - Cost of travel for Club vs Club; North Country pays for entry fee for Club vs Club; bring this back to your clubs
 - Junior and High School program weigh in and equipment
 - Are there any grants available for fizzing kits or information on fizzing lessons
 - Label this as a conservation project, try to get some grant money to get tables and equipment; maybe even cover fizzing kits for club members and tournament competitors.
- e. Looking for BOD help next year. President, Tournament Director, Youth Director. Nominations due in October. Voting takes place at December meeting. If no nominations are provided tonight, we will pull club names per the constitution item below:
